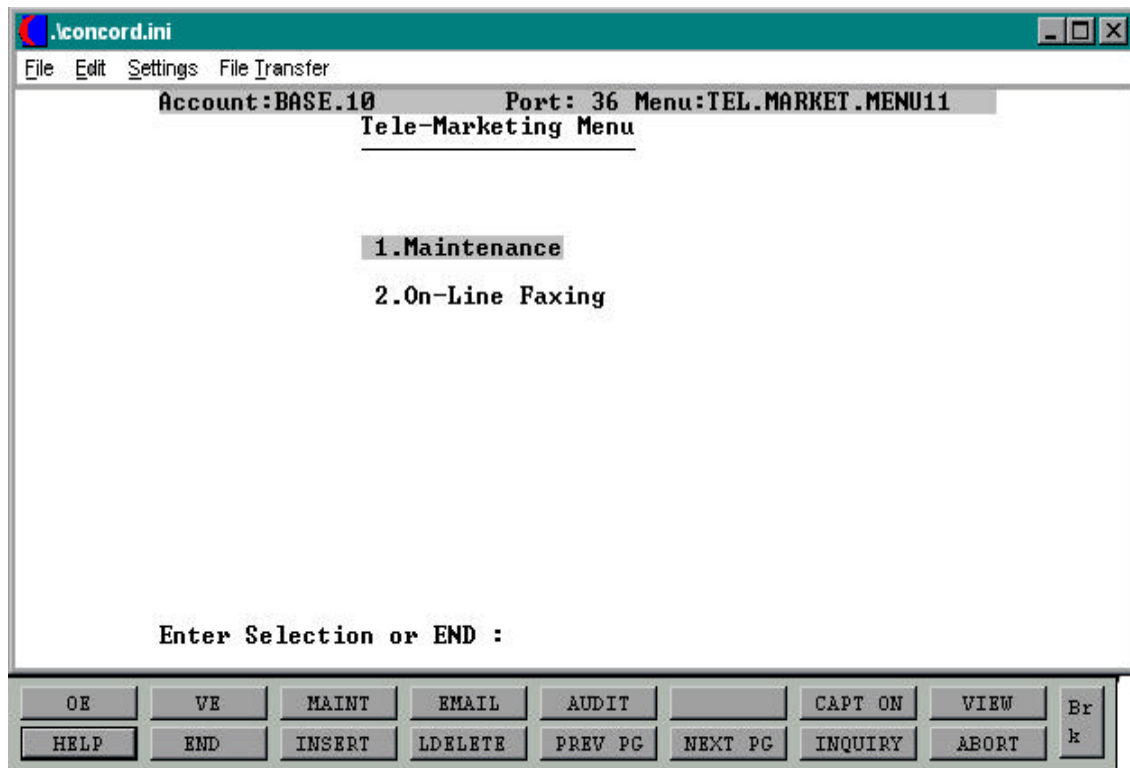

## TELEMARKETING MENU



## MASTER FILE MAINTENANCE FUNCTION KEYS

The first 8 function keys on your keyboard (F1-F8) are reserved for special functions in the MDS master file maintenance programs.

They appear on the last line of the screen as follows:

### FUNCTION KEY DEFINITION

#### **HELP**

The HELP function is available by pressing the F1 function key. Help text is set up as two layers. By pressing F1 at the first field on the screen, an overall description of the master file will be displayed. If F1 is pressed at a specific field within the master file a detailed description of the field and its use will be displayed.

#### **END**

The END function is available by pressing the F2 function key. This feature eliminated the need to manually type the word "END" at the end of the program after accepting the data.

#### **INSERT**

The INSERT function is available by pressing the F3 function key. The insert mode feature allows insertion of word or numbers into an existing text. Simply bring your cursor to the line or position in which you wish to insert and press F3. For example, if in a master file you wish to insert additional words into a description field or correct a spelling error, you may use the insert function to do so, rather than retype the text.

#### **LDELETE**

The LDELETE (line delete) function is available by pressing the F4 function key. The LDELETE function allows you to delete a line from the master file, in place of the \*, which is used in older versions of the system. Simply bring the cursor to the line or field you wish to delete and press F4.

The PREV PAGE (previous page) function is available by pressing the F5 key (SHIFT F1 for terminals supporting only 4 function keys). This function would be used for master files which contain multiple input screens, and will allow easy paging to additional screens. This function will be used simultaneously with the NEXT PG function to move back and forth between the screens.

**NEXT PG**

The NEXT PG (next page) function is available by pressing the F6 function key (SHIFT F2 for terminals supporting only 4 function keys). This function would be used for master files which contain multiple input screens, and will allow easy paging to additional screens. This function will be used simultaneously with the PREV PAGE function to move back and forth between the screens.

**INQUIRY**

The INQUIRY function is available by pressing the F7 function key (SHIFT F3 for terminals supporting only 4 function keys). This function allows the operator the flexibility to display items in the master file already entered and to display other master files used within the file being created. Example: The Product Master file. At the first prompt for product number if F7 is pressed an inquiry can be made to display product on file (to eliminate duplication). If you press the F7 key at another field for example product type (which is another master file) the system will display product types on file to help the operator in selecting which product type best fits the product being created. As you can see the inquiry function can be a very useful tool when creating or maintaining master files.

**ABORT**

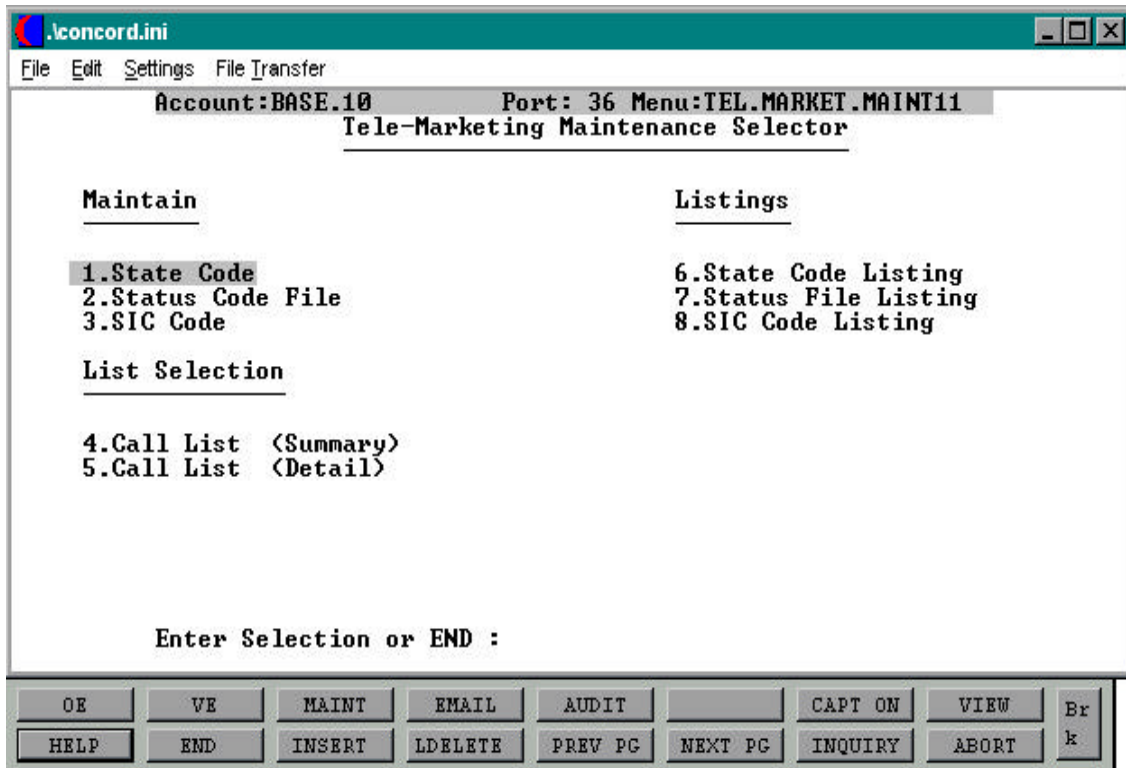
The ABORT function is available by pressing the F8 function key (SHIFT F4 for terminals supporting only 4 function keys). This function is used to end a program without applying changes or additions made and should only be used if you DO NOT want the changes to be updated to the file. If used, the record will be filed as it was before the operator accessed it, in other words, as though no changes were made.

The function keys listing above only apply to master file maintenance programs.

## TELEMARKETING MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES OVERVIEW

The purpose of this system is to integrate and streamline the telemarketing department and the information stored in MDS. The system outlined is a starting point. There are other features which may be incorporated in the future such as automated caller ID identification and automated outbound.

### OVERVIEW

The State Code file gives the tele-marketing system the ability to sort the calls that are made by time zones. This allows the operator to call through lists more efficiently. The state code is the key to this database and is a required file. The operator must enter a valid 2 digit abbreviation for the state being maintained or created. The operator will also have the ability to use the F7 inquiry key on this field and the resulting inquiry will list all state codes on file, sorted by code with description following.

By doing this the telemarketing programs will be able to determine which prospects will appear on the call list (discussed later in this documentation).

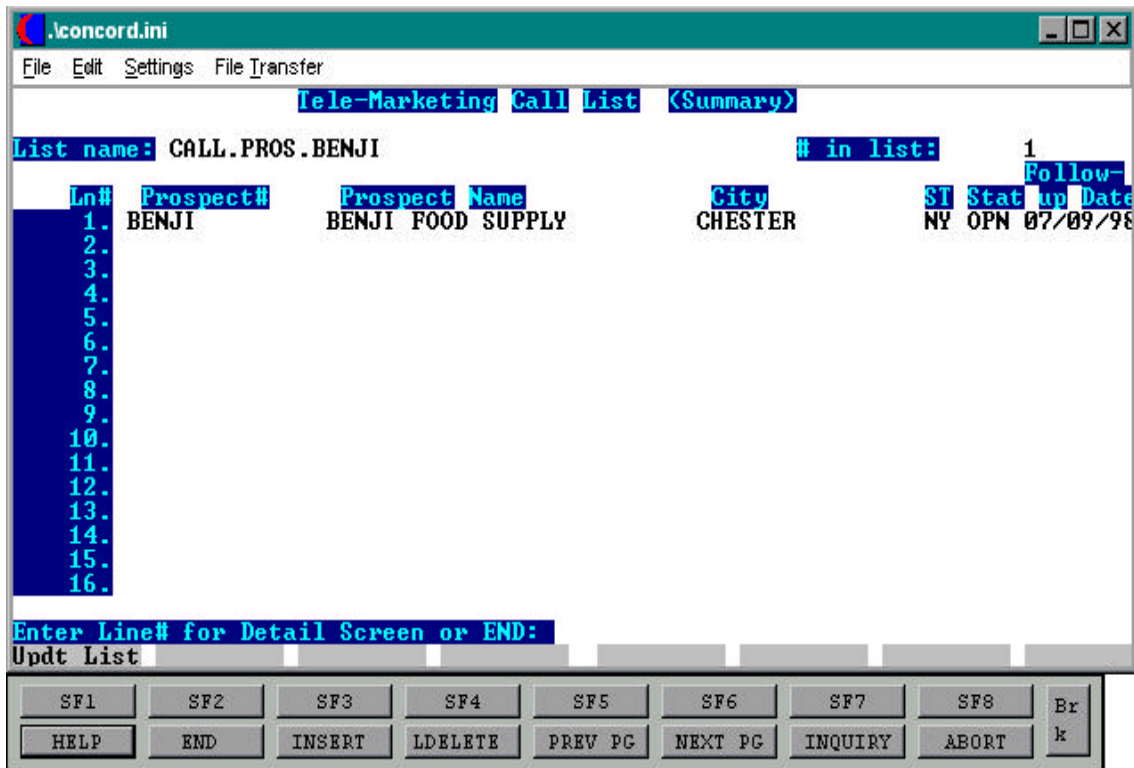

### OVERVIEW

The call list program works in conjunction with the recall generator module and is used by the tele-marketing department to produce lists to assist in calling prospects. The operator will create a recall report but instead of producing a report the information will be flagged to go directly to a saved list. Upon entry of the saved list name in the call list program, all calls with an open status will appear on the list indicating to the operator which prospects are to be called. Also available through this module is the automatic generation of daily call lists sorted by each salesman. These call lists will be produced through the end of day procedure and will be listed in the inquiry as daily calls, each list will contain a suffix, which will be each salesman number (Ex: DAILY.CALLS.001). Once the lists have been established the operator can view and update the list and also take orders over the phone. The operator can view the list in summary mode which will allow for easy scanning of call status and follow-up dates or select a specific line number to view the detail screen. The Shift 'F1' function is available and is used to remove all contact lines where the status code is not set to 'OPN'. This feature will allow you to remove records that have already been contacted.

**# IN LIST**

The number of prospects on this call list will display.

**LN#**

The line number for each prospect is displayed here.

**PROSPECT #**

The prospects customer number will display here.

**PROSPECT NAME**

The full name of the prospect will display here.

**CITY**

The city name from the Prospect file will display here.

**ST**

The state from the Prospect file will display here.

**STAT**

The status of the prospect will be displayed here from valid status codes on file.

**FOLLOW-UP DATE**

The date that this prospect should receive a follow-up call will be displayed here.



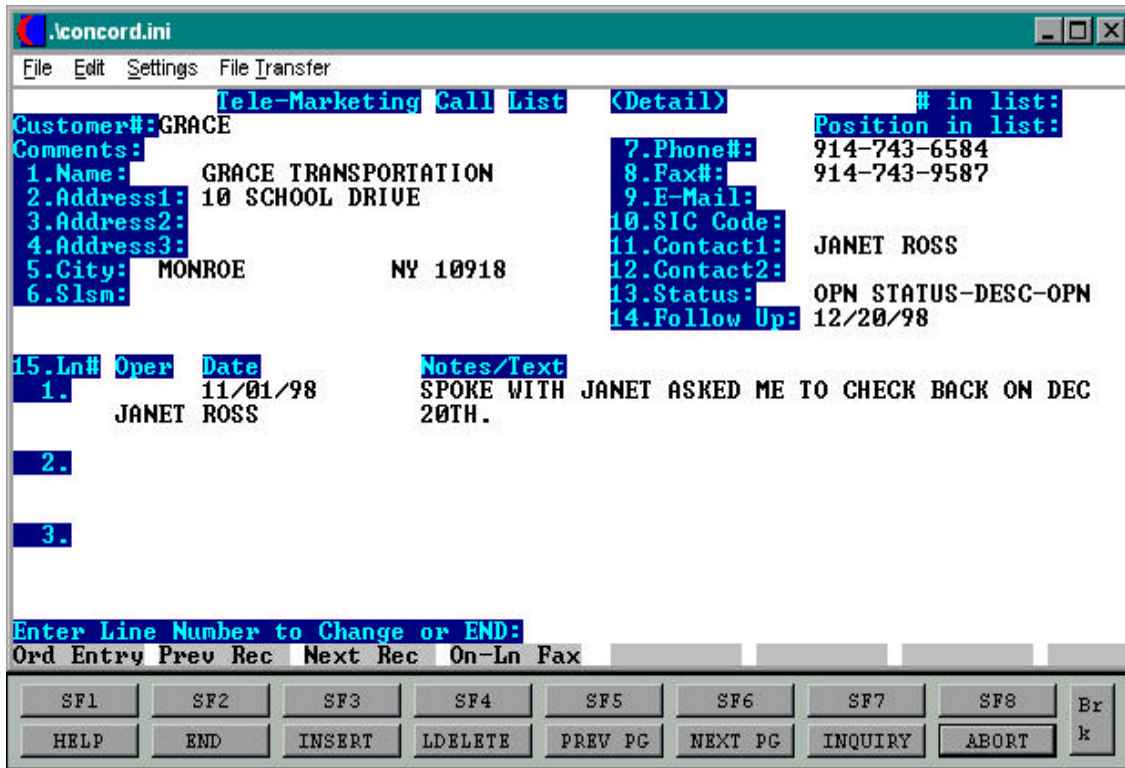

**OVERVIEW**

The call list detail screen is the same screen the operator accesses by selecting a specific line number in the call list summary screen. The operator will have the ability to maintain customer information on-line. This will allow the operator to validate and update the customers information while on the phone with them. There are several Shift functions available in this detail screen. Shift 'F1' will allow the operator to go directly into the order entry module and place an order for the customer they are speaking with. The Shift 'F2' function will allow the operator to view the details for the record that appears on the call list previous to the record the operator is in. The Shift 'F3' function allows the operator to view the details of the next record on the call list, and the Shift 'F4' function allows for on line faxing capabilities.

### OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### **CUSTOMER #**

Enter the customer number to view details.

#### **# IN LIST**

The number of records that are on the call list. This is valid when the detail screen is used via the summary mode and not as a stand alone maintenance.

#### **POSITION IN LIST**

The position that this record appears in the call list.

#### **COMMENTS**

Any comments or notes that need to be entered concerning this account can be entered here. This field can hold up to thirty alpha numeric characters. This field is optional and any data entered in this field will display here. The operator will have no ability to change this field from the screen.

#### **NAME**

The full name of the customer will display here.

#### **ADDRESS1**

The customers address will display here.

#### **ADDRESS2**

The second line of the customers address will display here.

#### **ADDRESS3**

The third line of the customers address will display here.

The city name will display here.

**SLSM**

The salesman number and name will display.

**PHONE #**

The prospects phone number will display here.

**FAX#**

The prospects fax number will display here.

**E-MAIL**

**SIC CODE**

SIC code will appear at this prompt from the Customer/Prospect file. The operator will have the ability to override this field. Any entry will be validated against the SIC Code database file. There is also an F7 inquiry capability here for the operator to display SIC codes that are already on file.

**CONTACT1**

The contacts name. This field is optional and will allow the operator to enter up to twenty five alpha numeric characters. There will be no validation against this field.

**CONTACT2**

If there is more than one contact the name can be entered here. This field is optional and will allow the operator to enter up to twenty five alpha numeric characters. There is no validation against this field.

## CALL LIST (DETAIL)

### OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### **STATUS**

The status of the this customer can be entered and will display here. The status field is used to catagorize customers. Some uses of this field would be to allow the operator to flag a particular customer as out of business, current customer, prospect only, etc. The operator will have 'F7' inquiry capabilities at this prompt that will display all status' on file.

#### **FOLLOW UP**

Enter the date you wish to make a follow up call. The follow up field is optional. If the operator enters a date in this field the system will then select this record for follow up during the automated end of day process when the date becomes due. The only validation of this field is the entry of a valid date. The operator will also have the ability to enter an older date into this field. This will cause the record to go to the top of the follow up list the next time it is generated.

#### **LN#**

The line number indicating the calls and or notes made concerning the prospect.

#### **OPER**

The operator field will default to the operator code entered to access the screen initially. The operator code can be overridden. There is no inquiry capabilities at this prompt and an entry in this field will be validated against the operator database.

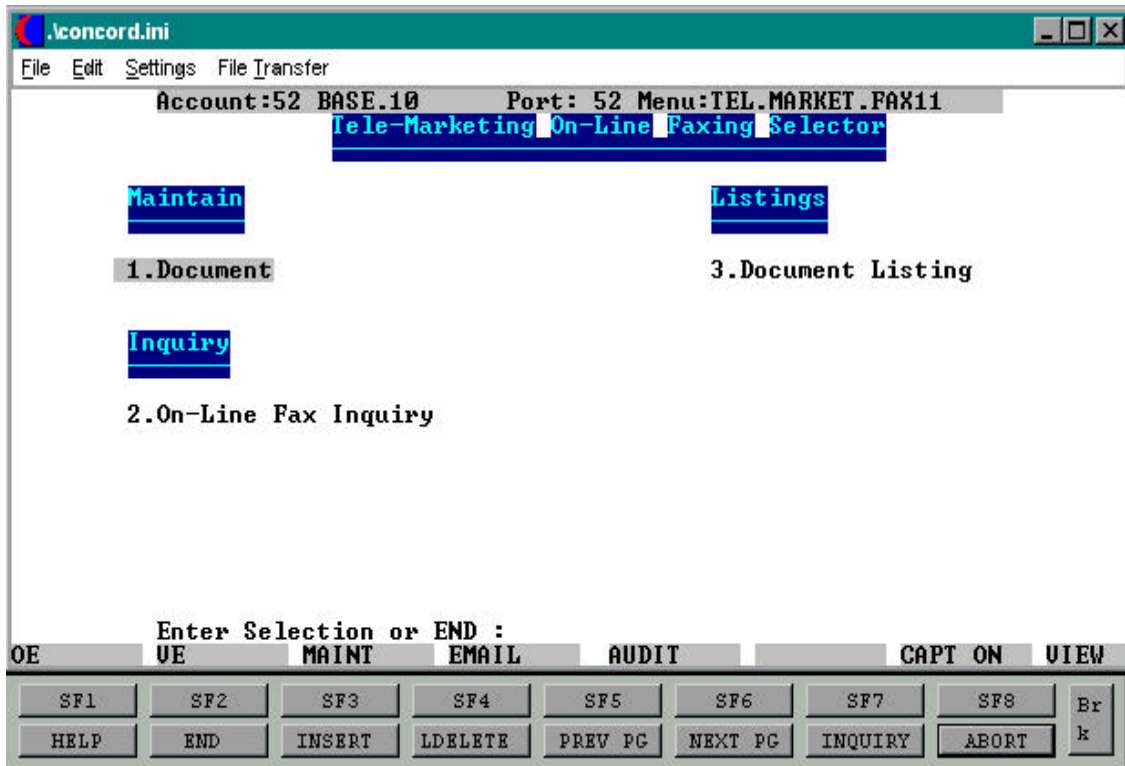
#### **DATE**

The date that the note was entered. The system will default to that days date if no entry is made.

#### **NOTES/TEXT**

Any comments or notes concerning the call can be entered here. Notes will generally be added by the salesman. The salesman will select a note line number and then use the 'F4' function key to insert lines and add to a note.

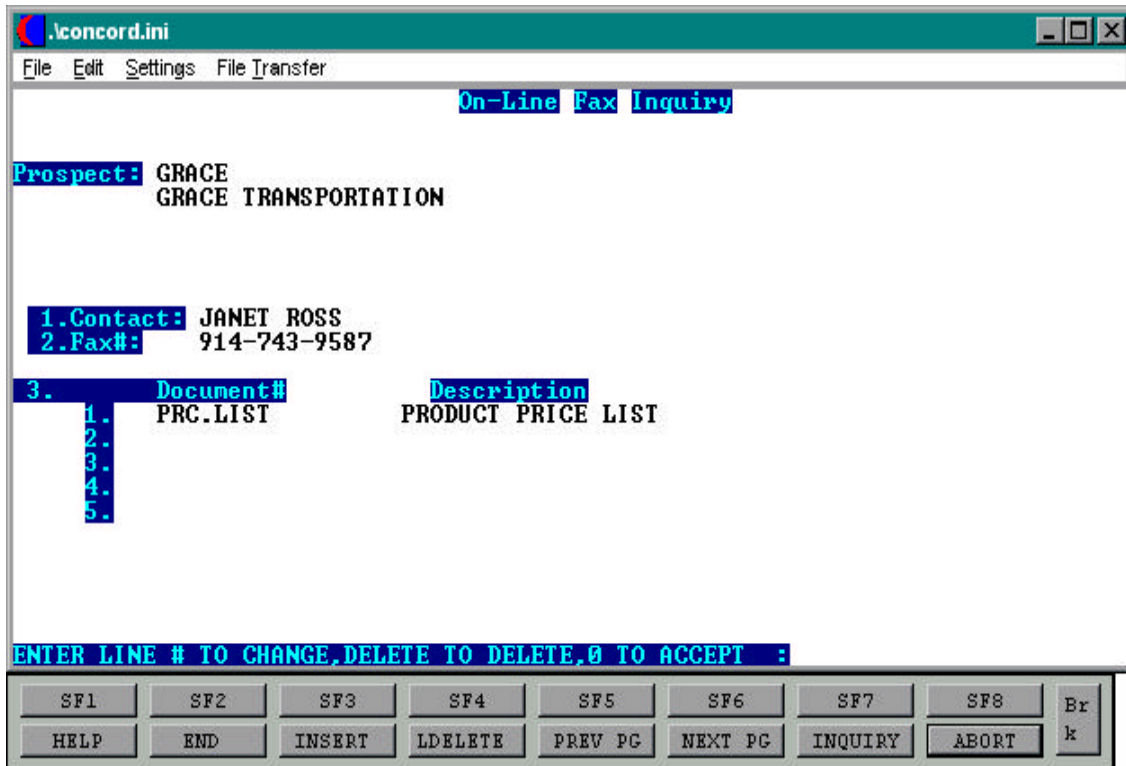

**OVERVIEW**

The on-line fax inquiry is where the prospect or customer is setup to receive faxes. The module allows for the input of the customer name and fax number as well as the names of the documents that will be faxed.

**CONTACT**

Enter the full name of the contact who the fax is intended.

**FAX#**

Enter the fax phone number.

**DESCRIPTION**

Upon entry of the document code, the description of what the code is will display from the Document.Maint file.

After entering the required information the program will prompt:

**OK TO FAX <Y/N>?**

Enter 'Y' to fax a the desired documents or enter 'N' to return to the selector.
